HYSTEROSALPINGOGRAM Taken at the Royal Northern Hospital 3.12.86

I did not have the benefit of the fluoroscopic findings, but the right fallopian tube appears well outlined and there is peritoneal spill. The appearance of the left tube is unusual. The proximal part is reasonably seen and part of what I take to be the distal part running more medially is also seen but details of the fimbria are not visible on this radiograph. Close to the interuption of the column there are two small short parallel opacities. Has there been any operative intervention in relation to the left tube or is there any history of application of clips etc, in this region. Is there any relevant history. I would be pleased to discuss this further if you wish over the telephone.
